2023 Product Safety Position Letter

It is EnduraPack's Policy to design, manufacture and sell products that are both safe and of a high level of craftsmanship. We do this by committing ourselves to this goal from our President and CEO, down through our raw materials vendors and throughout the entire supply chain.

EnduraPack's (EP) approach to product safety is outlined below.

1. EP became PPAI Safety Ambassador early on.
2. EP adopted the PPAI Code of Conduct.
3. EP created a similar Code of Conduct and required our overseas partners' management to read, comply and sign our Code of Conduct.
4. EP continues to seek out continuous education, seminars, and events, regulatory agency information, testing and certification agencies information to keep us current in matters related to product safety and compliance.
5. EP networks with distributors and other manufacturers in the industry who work in compliance and product safety on a regular basis.
6. EP does not back down from a compliance challenge. Example: PIC Program requesting testing while manufacturing the order.
7. EP requests all salespeople to send child-related bag concepts and/or artwork to be reviewed prior to production or quoting.
8. EP Complies with all regulatory requirements for product safety, testing and labeling.
9. EP applies consistent safety standards across our entire product line and we make sure that our supply chain meets those standards by a thorough design risk assessment and stringent product specifications.
10. EP sources our raw materials only from suppliers that we have evaluated and approved. We have tested those products with certified 3rd party laboratories.
